### **Trip Discipline Policies**

This trip has been planned to enrich our students' educational experience as well as add to their appreciation of our history and our environment. However, please keep in mind that the trip is a privilege, not a right. A student's *grades*, *attendance*, and *attitude* are key factors in determining her/his successful participation in the trip. Listed below are disciplinary actions that will keep a student from being allowed to go on the trip.

If any of the following occur during the second (2<sup>nd</sup>) semester the student will be removed from the trip.

- Two days (2) of out-of-school suspension
- Three (3) days of in-school suspension

# Student expulsion at any time during the year will result in automatic removal from the trip.

The staff at BWIS reserves the right to refuse participation to any student who has unsatisfactory academic performance, has been a source of disruption or discipline problems, has had attendance problems, or whom they believe would jeopardize the smooth operation of the trip. A meeting, which may include Mr. Wion, Mrs. Pentello, your child's teachers, Mrs. Wytzka, and Mr. McLane will be scheduled prior to the loss of Heartland Outdoor school participation.

### DISCIPLINE DURING TRIP

Any student in violation of the rules defined in the BWIS Student Handbook during the trip may be sent home. Parents will be responsible for transporting their child home. Be sure to discuss this possibility with your child as there will be NO REFUND.

### ATTENDANCE POLICY

Students who are absent twenty (20) days or more from school may not be allowed to go on the trip unless they have a serious illness and have been under a doctor's care. A doctor's excuse must be brought in.

### **GRADE POLICY**

Any student who is not passing three (3) of his/her four core classes (Language Arts, Math, Science, Social Studies) at the end of the third (3<sup>rd</sup>) nine weeks may be excluded from the trip.

#### **School Fee and Forms Policy**

To attend this trip all School Fees must be paid, or have a payment plan approved through the Treasurer's Office. All BWI Emergency Medical forms must be turned in as well.
